CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. U12 – born in 2009 or later: U14 – born in 2007 or later: U16 – born in 2005 or later: U18 – born in 2003 or later: 17-21 born in 2002, 2001, 2000 or 1999 only. All entrants must have resided in Kent for at least three months prior to the tournament, or currently go to school in Kent, or have been born in Kent and must not have accepted a place in any other county squad for the upcoming season, or played for another county in the preceding three months. Entrants should be prepared to represent the County if so invited.
2. Competitors may enter events at one age group only but may additionally enter the U18 mixed event if so entitled. The 17-21 competition is open to competitors of the appropriate age only and is not open to younger players.
3. If there is a lack of entries at any age group, the committee reserve the right to play the group either as a unisex event or to merge it with another age group.
4. The tournament is organised by Kent Badminton Ltd and shall take place in accordance with the tournament regulations adopted by Badminton England as altered or amended herein.
5. A separate entry form must be completed by each competitor. The entry fee is £10.00 per event per person. Cheques payable to Kent Badminton Ltd or electronic payments to HSBC sort code 40-15-05 account number 61761110 quoting JNRCHAL20 and your surname.
6. BOGOF Discount = “Buy One Get One Free”. For every event played in the Junior Restricted in September 2019 you may enter up to the same number of events in this Challenge, free of charge. For example, if you played in 2 events in the Junior Restricted, you may play two events in the 2020 Challenge free of charge. If you played 1 event in the Junior Restricted but wish to play 3 events in the Challenge, the first is free, you only pay for the other 2 events.
7. Entries may have to be restricted if numbers prove too large. If this is the case the procedure laid down by B. E. for tournaments will apply.
8. The tournament committee reserve the right to refuse an entry without assigning any reason. The tournament committee’s decision is final.
9. Competitors will receive an email of confirmation and check-in time at least seven days before the event, unless a SAE is included for a letter of confirmation. Competitors should contact the Secretary should notification not have been received within 4 days of the date of play.
10. All competitors must report to the referee’s table on arrival. Competitors will be scratched if not ready to play when called upon, and must not leave the hall without permission. Tournament fees are not refundable at any time, except as stated in paragraph 14.

11. Competitors should wear recognised badminton clothing, and any advertising on clothing must fall within the B.E. regulations. Tracksuits may only be worn in knock-ups.
12. The draw for all events will be seeded.
13. Events will be run in pools, with each player playing all those in the same pool. Where numbers allow, winners and runners up will progress to the knockout rounds. The committee reserve the right to modify the programme if necessary.
14. The committee will try to find partners for any doubles event if competitors are unable to find their own, but no guarantee can be given. If you want a partner, write "partner wanted" on the entry form under "partner's name". Your event fee must be included, but will be refunded if the committee is unable to find you a partner.
15. Coaching of players whilst a match is in progress is **not** permitted.
16. Trophies or medals will be presented to winners, runners-up and losing semi-finalists.
17. The tournament committee cannot accept responsibility for any lost property, nor for personal injury sustained by any competitor.
18. Tournament regulations 10 penalty system. We are obliged to apply the B.E. penalty system, maximum penalties as follows: (a) failure to arrive without notification £100 (b) failure to arrive with notification but without proper reason - £50 (c) late arrival on court without proper reason - £20.
19. Videoing and photography is not permitted in the hall without the express and prior permission of the referee. Flash photography is not permitted in the hall at any time whilst play is in progress. Photographs may be taken for publicity purposes at such times and in such locations as the referee may determine. Should you not wish your photograph to be taken, this should be notified to the referee.
